### What is the PAVE Program?

Peer Advisors for Veteran Education ([PAVE](#)) is a peer support program that connects incoming veterans with student veterans on campus to help them navigate college life and ease the transition from the military to academia.

PAVE Peer Advisors help identify any challenges that student veterans are facing and help locate appropriate resources on- or off- campus while providing ongoing support to help student veterans meet academic and personal goals.

Student Veterans of America works with the PAVE program to hire and train Peer Advisor Leads at Auburn University, Central Michigan University, George Washington University, University of Maryland, and the University of Michigan.
